SUN Community Schools aim to extend the school day and develop local schools as community centers. We all work together at Bridger to meet the needs of our students and their families. In order to provide your child and family with the best services and support possible, we need your permission to be able to share information with each other which will help us better meet the needs of each child.

By enrolling the child listed above in SUN Community School (SUN CS) activities, I understand that I am authorizing the release and exchange of student records between Portland Public Schools (Bridger Elementary), Impact Northwest SUN CS employees and volunteers, and partners designated below. Notice of Non-discrimination

Behavioral Expectations

The safety and well-being of all participants and staff is of utmost importance. To ensure safety in SUN Community Schools, we require that all participants be able to follow all three of the following criteria:
